The Monterey Bay is an amazing place to view marine mammals

like sea otters, seals, and sea lions. Officials at the Monterey Bay National Marine Sanctuary sent us a reminder about important safety guidelines and federal regulations for those of us who spend time in the Bay. Here are a few guidelines for swimmers, kayakers, SUPers, and boaters:

- Federal law states that people must stay at least 150 feet from sea otters.
- If an otter or any marine mammal keeps eye contact with someone, that is a sign that the person is too close and that the animal is wary of future actions or movements.
- If an animal must swim away, then the person is too close to the animal.
- No one should ever pursue or chase an otter or any other marine mammal.
- Otters like all other marine mammals are protected under Federal Law, the Marine Mammal Protection Act, and many marine mammals are also further protected under the Federal Endangered Species Act.
- Chasing, pursuing or touching any of these animals is not only dangerous, but is also a Federal offense that can carry hefty fines.

Tennis Tip The Ticket for a Better Forehand.

After observing match play on the courts of The Beach & Tennis Club, I have put together three ideas to help each and every one of you to hit a stronger forehand.

1. EARLY PREPARATION: This means the racquet is going back as soon as you have determined your opponents shot is going to your forehand. It does not matter if you have a loop on your backswing or if you pull your racquet straight back. You must get the racquet back as quickly as possible in order to be ready for the shot.

2. ELBOW IN: I took note that the good forehands had an important trait; in that the elbow stayed somewhat close by to the body on the take back (Back swing) and slowly moved away as each player goes closer to the point of contact. This action gives the shot stability and the stroke itself will become more consistent.

3. FINISH YOUR STROKE: The players that hit strong forehands continue through their stroke after they have made contact with the ball. Not only will you have better ball control but it will enable you to hit with additional depth and power (elements we all are looking striving for).

These three tips will help you deliver a stroke off your forehand side that will contain depth, control, and power. What more could a player ask for when they step on the court? That is your ticket for a better forehand. See you on the courts!
