Location

- Southern coast of the Monterey Peninsula, on Carmel Bay about six miles from downtown Monterey
- Within Del Monte Forest and accessible via 17-Mile Drive

- Built in 1919
- 155 luxury guest rooms, 5 spa rooms and 1 spa suite
- Overlooking the 18th hole at Pebble Beach Golf Links and Carmel Bay

Dining & Restaurants

Stillwater Bar & Grill

- Seats 80, on the entrance level of the main building, with beautiful views of Stillwater Cove and Carmel Bay
- Serving breakfast, lunch and dinner daily
- Specializing in the finest fresh seafood, prepared in your choice of six different ways

The Terrace Lounge

- Adjacent to Stillwater Bar & Grill
- Serves as a lounge and reception area for The Lodge

The Tap Room

- Seats 85, located near the lobby in the main building
- Patterned after an English pub featuring a fascinating collection of golf memorabilia from the AT&T Pebble Beach National Pro-Am and the 1972, '82, '92, 2000 and 2010 U. S. Open Championships
- Menu includes an excellent selection of American steakhouse favorites

Gallery Cafe

- Seats 97, across from The Lodge, above the shops of the retail promenade
- Restaurant and bar serving breakfast and lunch
- Outdoor deck overlooking the first tee of Pebble Beach Golf Links

The Beach & Tennis Club™

- Spectacular ocean-front location, adjacent to the 17th hole at Pebble Beach Golf Links
- Serving lunch and Sunday brunch only
- Guests of Pebble Beach Resorts are welcome

- 22,000 square feet with 15 massage rooms, five facial rooms, full service salon, and barber room
- Specialized massages, facials, unique body wraps
