Treasured time with family & friends, is always increased whenever the classic yellow label from the famed champagne house Veuve Clicquot is opened. Heightened anticipation is sure to build, upon pouring these classic bubbles for your guests.

2009 Handley Cellars Pinot Gris - \$16 / \$13.60 per bottle

Dry, rich, with a full body, supple texture, & smooth, long finish, truly a great value. Hint of pink, inviting guests to be seated around the dinner table. Aromas, pear, lemon peel, roasted nut, peach, & apple blossom. Flavors carry over onto palate & mingle with some earthiness adding dimension to honeyed apple & pear flavors. The bright acidity & richness begs the next sip. Hints of clove spice linger on the finish, presents Handley's rendition as juicy & fresh, with enough edge to match your dinner. Good companion for adventurous culinary explorations & for sipping by itself, a perfect pairing for your guest's experience.

2009 Handley Cellars Gewurztraminer - \$16 / \$13.60 per bottle

Balanced enough to be served as an aperitif, or for your guests to enjoy seated around the table. Aromas, lavender, honeysuckle, pear, white peaches, & orange zest. Flavors carry over on palate & mingle with grapefruit, citrus, lychee, & hint baking spice on finish. Fresh with hints of clove spice lingering on the satisfying finish, with a rich texture, making it great with many cheeses, & turkey dinner.

2007 Handley Cellars Pinot Noir - \$24 / \$20.40 per bottle

Unbelievably good at this or any price from cool climate Mendocino appellation, the ideal partner to any holiday dinner. A fine sample of a fruit-forward, multi-layered pinot noir. Aromas of blackberry & dark plum, with nuances of dried cherry, blueberry, cinnamon & vanilla, finishing with hints raspberry & suggestion of toast. Smooth texture carries flavor into a long finish. Versatile with food, not too heavy to drown the lighter dishes, but fruity and spicy enough to go with turkey and other light meats and all of the trimmings that follow. Delicious!

2009 Foxglove Chardonnay - \$14 / \$11.90 per bottle

Non-oaked, stainless steel-fermented & aged white that sees no malolactic fermentation. Two-thirds Santa Barbara County fruit & the rest from Paso Robles, & further north in our local Monterey appellation. Exhibits crisp honeyed lemon, citrus, poached pear, & honeysuckle notes intermixed with a hint of pineapple. It is the zesty acidity, stunning purity, & delightful balance this naked Chardonnay possesses that make it so appealing, & so right to pair with any holiday meal.

2010 Etude Rose' of Pinot Noir - \$20 / \$17 per bottle

A local Napa Valley favorite, & 100% Estate. Salmon-pink in color, with aromas fresh strawberries, red cherries & sweet blood oranges. Flavors fill the mouth of strawberry rhubarb & cherries on the palate with a pleasing note of minerality. Perfectly-balanced acidity, & truly, a wonderful complement to your holiday dinner, from start to finish.

2007 Joseph Phelps Napa Cabernet Sauvignon - \$56 / \$47.60 per bottle

There are those that want a Cab on the table no matter what is being served. This is an excellent option if you or a family member fall into this category. Phelps' basic Cabernet bottling is dry & elegant, & classically balanced. It displays rich flavors of blackberries, black currants & cedar, with notes of violets & herbs. Fancy & impressive now, a perfect fit for a Cab Lover on any holiday...especially if a red meat is the choice of entrée for dinner.
